Nanomaterials in North America Statement

United States

The P&G Chemicals Glycerin product(s) listed above is (are) not considered to meet the definition of a reportable nanomaterial as defined by the US EPA's TSCA nano-reporting rule.

Canada

Paragraph 71(1)(b) of the Canadian Environmental Protection Act, 1999, and the July 25, 2015 "Notice with respect to certain nanomaterials in Canadian commerce" (the Notice) requires nanomaterial reporting and for the purpose of this declaration the definition of nanomaterial is as issued in the Guidance document for completing the CEPA section 71 Notice with respect to certain nanomaterials in Canadian commerce:

A substance that has a size of between 1 and 100 nanometers in at least one external dimension, or internal or surface structure and is provided in the Notice Schedule 1 list. Furthermore, a substance is considered to be a nanomaterial if it has 10% or more, by number count, of its particles in the nanoscale range (1 to 100 nanometers, inclusive).
