Bio Terrorism, FDA Registration, & CTPAT Statement

This letter is to provide notification to your company that Onset Worldwide is registered with the Food and Drug Administration in compliance with The Public Health Security and Bioterrorism Preparedness and Response Act of 2002, and its subsequent stated Interim Final Rule Regulations. We have renewed registration as of October 3, 2024, with an updated Registration Expiration Date of December 31, 2026. We have been instructed by the FDA to treat the FDA issued facility registration numbers as confidential. Accordingly, until further notice, Onset Worldwide will provide FDA facility numbers only to Government agencies and when required to support specific product transactions.

Onset Worldwide's Quality Team is competent in the aspects of food safety and properly trained for the position including PCQI, HACCP and Internal Auditing Certifications.

Onset Worldwide is a certified member of C-TPAT (Customs-Trade Partnership Against Terrorism), a supply chain security program established by U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP). Membership in C-TPAT requires that our company and its business partners commit to minimizing the risk of unauthorized and/or dangerous goods entering the U.S. in one of our shipments. This commitment requires, among other things, that we ask our business partners to analyze their physical security and internal control procedures, and certify that they have taken the necessary steps to protect their part of the supply chain. Onset Worldwide has also taken these steps and was audited in 2017, 2022, & 2025 to be a certified member of the C-TPAT program; subsequent years have been a Customs documentation audit review annually.
