In 2013, the FDA defined “gluten” as the protein, or antigenic fraction proteins, present in wheat, barley, rye, or related grain species or cross-bred varieties or derivatives thereof to which some people are intolerant or allergic.

ADM corn sweeteners are produced from the wet milling of corn, and therefor are not included in the FDA definition. However, corn does contain insoluble proteins, but it does not contain the gliadin protein that is responsible for celiac sprue disease. Corn sweeteners may be safely consumed by persons with this condition.
